Prof. Kumar Molugaram, Principal, welcomed the esteemed members to the 30th Academic Council meeting of the University College of Engineering (A), OU, which was being conducted about two months late due to the COVID -19 pandemic situation.

He informed the external members that since the classes for the next academic year will commence on 1st September 2020, the Head of the Departments of the University College of Engineering have conducted the Board of Studies meeting (online) of their respective departments, for revision of the syllabus of certain UG and PG courses which they shall present before the August body.

Subsequently he gave a presentation on the history of the college in brief and the various developments in the college for the last one year which included the following points:

- A brief history of the College which started off in the year 1929 with just the Department of Civil Engineering and the youngest department being the Department of Computer Science Engineering in the year 1985. The College is now offering both UG and PG programs in six branches of Engineering and is a 91 year old legacy Institution.
- The intake of the various UG and PG programs in the six branches of Engineering offered by the College and also the supernumerary intake of 10% for Lateral Entry students in the second year and 10% for foreign students.
- All the under graduate courses offered by the College are accredited by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) in the year 2019, with Bio-Medical Engineering getting the accreditation for 6 years and all other branches for 3 years.

- The NBA accreditation is due for all the 24 PG courses offered by the College. The pre-qualifiers for 11 out of 24 PG Programs offered by the college have already been uploaded as detailed below:

The college could not go for accreditation of other PG programs due to lack of sufficient Faculty Student Ratio.

- The College has UGC autonomy up to 2022.
- The College has received grants to the tune of 34 crores under TEQIP I, II and III and now the focus is on TEQIP IV which shall involve Research and Patents
- The College has obtained 88th rank in the NIRF 2020 rankings. The marks obtained have increased but the rank remained the same due to huge competition.
- The College has initiated 'total automation' and 90% of the process is complete. The Examination Cell of the College is fully automated. Receipts are also digitalized. Only payments part remains to be automated which will be done in the next couple of months.
- The College is sanctioned 10 crores under RUSA, of which 2.5 crores is already received towards teaching and learning improvements. Three units of RUSA, namely Cyber Security, Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning and One Mini-centre worth one crore have been established in the University College of Engineering, OU.
- As regards Placements for the year 2020, students numbering 278 have got placements, with an average pay of Rs.6.75 per annum and the highest pay being Rs.17 lakhs per annum

- An MoU has been signed with M/s. Tigris under which a few workshops have been organized in the college.
- A grant of Rs.24 lakhs was received by the college under Vishvesvaraya Ph.D. Scheme. A total of Nine candidates have been selected under the scheme for the year 2019-2020 for the Ph D. Programme and each student shall receive 2.5 lakhs as fellowship by the end of the Ph.D programme.
- The Department of Computer Science Engineering is starting a new Program in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AI&ML) from the academic year 2020-21 with an intake of 60 students.
- The QIP Centre established in the college in 2018-19 under which the interviews for selection of candidates for admission into Ph.D is completed for the year 2020-21, and the final list is awaited from the Central Government.
- The College is sanctioned with Research Projects from UGC, DST, SERB and also from Private organizations.
- Several courses are offered by the college faculty under NPTEL and Swayam portals for both the students and the faculty.
- The college has received an IRG to the tune of 6.1 Crores mainly due to the support of our faculty and the efforts of the institute.

Faculty level achievements:

- Prof. Kumar Molugaram, Principal has been appointed as a member of the Executive Council of Osmania University by the Government of Telangana, and also the Convener for PGE CET for the years 2019 and 2020.
- Prof. Sriram Venkatesh, Department of Mechanical Engineering received the Best Teacher Award for the year 2019 from the Government of Telangana.
- Prof. Mallesham, Department of Electrical Engineering, was awarded the Best Engineer of the year 2019.

Departmental level achievements:

- The BME Department has applied for 6 patents, Electrical Engineering Department has applied for 4 patents and the CSE Department has applied for one patent and the results are awaited.
- Our faculty was sanctioned a total of 3 SERB projects , each worth 45 lakhs in the year 2018-2019 and one project in the year 2019-20 to the tune of 38 lakhs.
- Seven Gyan Programs were organized by the Departments
- One SPARC project worth 75 lakhs was sanctioned to the Department of Civil Engineering
- An Indo-Srilankan International Project worth Rs.25 lakhs was sanctioned to the Department of Electrical Engineering, in the year 2019.
- The faculty from various departments have applied for 6 SERB Projects and 10 UGC Minor research projects for grants worth 300 lakhs, and the results are awaited.

- Two Atal Entity projects have been sanctioned by the MHRD, New Delhi.

Student level achievements:

- Ms. Gayathri from the Department of ECE has secured 37th rank in the IES 2018 Examination.
- Mr. J.Srinathan, has secured 5th Rank in GATE for the year 2020
- 150 students of the College have applied for GATE and 97 have qualified in the year 2020.
- Mr. Sagar Kumar, a final year student secured 9th rank in GATE 2020.

Faculty centric policies of the college:

- The faculty from the college have been deputed to premier institutes such as IITs, NITs and IIMs for higher studies/exchange programs etc.
- Also about 25 to 30 faculty members were deputed to attend Capacity Building Programs in various IIMs under TEQIP III
- The College is now equipped with a new e-committee room with digital podium, digital board, sound system etc.. The committee room has a seating capacity of 60 persons. This facility was created recently with UPE funding.
- 385 desktops were purchased and distributed to all the departments of the college for the faculty and students.
- All computer labs are renovated with state of art specifications in computer labs.
- Seed money is offered to Faculty doing Ph.D. work along with reimbursement of Registration fee, TA/DA for attending conferences and seminars under TEQIP III.

Student centric policies of the college:

- A 30 days (60 hours) Training Programme for the 6th Semester students on Employability skills by TIME Institute was organized from 5 to 7 p.m. under TEQIP III
- 207 BE students have registered for GATE 2020 and three Mock Tests were conducted the college before the GATE entrance. Also in the year 2019 2 students got a rank less than 100.
- Bridge courses were encouraged for Lateral Entry students admitted in the 2nd year of study
- Four ideas were examined by the Start Up Cell of the College, which is very active. Dr. E. Vidya Sagar is the coordinator for the Start Up cell. Also some support was also given for a 4th year ECE student of our college for his startup idea.
- The Technical Festival was conducted by the all the Departments individually on 13th & 14th March 2020 for which some TEQIP funding was given.
- Hackaton Programmes are very regular in all the departments.

- The NSS and NCC Units are very active in the college and organizes several programmes.
- The NPTEL Local Chapter was established in the College in 2018 and Dr. L. Sivaramakrishna is the Coordinator for this unit. Under this, some of the faculty registered themselves between July –Oct.2019 for some courses and have also obtained Certificates. About 128 students have also registered for various courses under NPTEL.
- Under the guidance of the Start-up Cell, three students have come up with ideas. Two students Mr. Mohd. Sohail and Mr. Jabber from Mechanical Engineering have come up with an idea, which was initiated in March 2019 on “Adjustable heel footwear for Ladies, namely a) Manual heel turnable ladies footwear and b) Automatic heel turnable ladies footwear, which is likely to be marketed by the end of this year. Also Mr. Kiran from Dept. of Bio Medical Engineering has submitted one idea “Fight against COVID” which is under process and results are awaited.
- Various student clubs were started in the year 2019 and 2020 such as Music Club & Idea Club respectively. The Music Club is very active and have showcased their talent in various official functions. Also Photography & Arts Club and Sports Club were also established in the year 2020. All these Clubs have Faculty members as Coordinators to guide the students in excelling in the field of their interest.

Academic Curriculum

- As regards Academic curriculum, every year before the academic year commences a draft curriculum / syllabus along with the related rules and regulations are thoroughly discussed in the Board of Studies Meetings conducted in every department. This board also consists of external members from academia / industry and based on their inputs and suggestions changes and made and a draft is prepared. The Director, CDAAC reviews the same, and the draft is placed before the Academic Council for its perusal & approval. Based on the suggestions of the members the syllabus is then finalized and conveyed to the departments, faculty and students and is also put up on the college website.
- A three week Induction Programme is conducted for the first year first semester BE students from the academic year 2018-2019. Also AICTE syllabus has been adopted from 2018-2019 for these students.
- The AICTE syllabus was adopted for PG students from the year 2019-2020.

Faculty Status:

The College has a faculty strength of 132 of which 28 are Professors, 23 Associate Professors and 37 Assistant Professors who are Regular and 39 Assistant Professors who are on Contractual appointments. Also we have 5 Adjunct Professors in two of our departments.

Seminars/Worshops:

- The college organized a 3 day national workshop on “Outcome of NBA Process” and there were 175 participants for the same
- A two day Interational Conference in “Emerging Trends in Engineering” ws organized in March 2019.
- 20 online seminars/webinars were conducted by the college
- 30 regular workshops were conducted before the COVID lockdown in the year 2019-2020.

Central Facilities:

The Central Facilities of the college include a Library, Placement Cell, Examination Cell, Department of Physical Education, NSS, NCC, etc. The College Library has more than 1 lakh books. Also e books from IEEE are available and the faculty and students have access to them for which 40 desktops are also installed in the library.

After his presentation, the Principal requested Prof. N. Suresh Kumar, Director, CDAAC to address the members and take up the agenda items.

Prof. N. Suresh Kumar, Director, CDAAC, explained in brief the Agenda items to be taken up in the meeting and requested the Head of the Departments of the College to place the recommendations of the Board of Studies for the approval of the Academic Council.
